

GHOULISH RAK ROCKS

Are you ready for a spook-tacular and creative Halloween project?

This activity adds a unique touch to Halloween while also spreading kindness and creativity within your community.

STEP 1: GATHER SUPPLIES

You will need:

- Smooth, clean rocks (various sizes)
- Acrylic paint or paint markers (various colors)
- Paintbrushes (if using acrylic paint)
- Sealant spray (optional, for weatherproofing)
- Blank cards or cardstock
- Markers, stickers, or decorative items for the adoption cards



STEP 2: DESIGN YOUR GHOULISH FIGURES

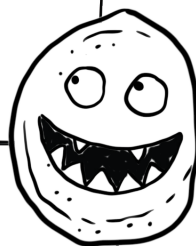

STEP 3: CREATE ADOPTION CARDS

- **Prepare Your Cards:** Take the blank cards and cut them into the desired size.
- **Design the Cards:** Write a cute adoption message on each card - or can download and print the one we made (see page 2).
- **Decorate:** Use markers and stickers to make the cards colorful and inviting.
- **Encourage Sharing:** Invite new caregivers to capture their ghouls in their natural environments and encourage them to share on social media using #GhoulisnRAKRocks.

STEP 4: ASSEMBLE THE GHOULISH ROCKS AND CARDS

- **Pair Rocks with Cards:** Pair each rock with its corresponding adoption card.
- **Set Up a Distribution Station:** Create a display at your front door or yard.

STEP 5: SHARE THE JOY

- **Encourage Participation:** Invite friends and family to join in the fun!
- **Spread the Word:** Share photos of your creations on social media with hashtag, #GhoulisnRAKRocks
